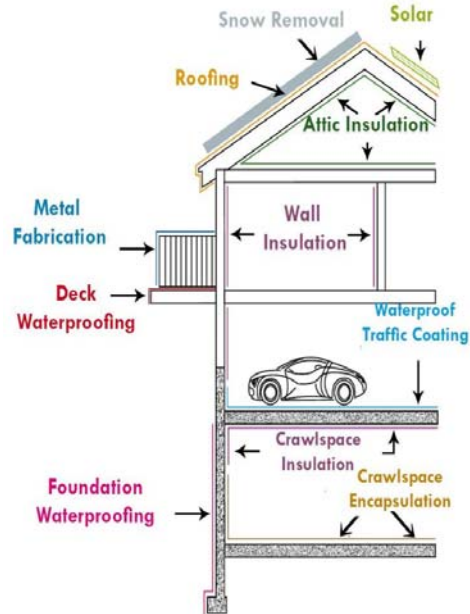

axes to break up the ice on the roof.

These tools can cut through the roof exterior causing more damage than

the ice would have. TRC uses rubber mallets, covers window wells with plywood and is always aware of the surfaces underneath the ice. We always remove the roof snow from walk paths and driveways before leaving the site. TRC follows all of the OSHA safety guidelines and has an internal safety plan that is enforced as well.

Mike is responsible for our Winter Maintenance program, which allows TRC to monitor the snow and/or ice dam situation on each house. The program consists of bi-weekly property inspections and bi-weekly emails updating the property owner with snow and ice removal suggestions indicated by photographs. Once the property owner approves the work, TRC will remove the bulk of the snow insuring that all of the roof's ventilation systems are free and clear to function properly. Then the crew chips and directs ice dams to ensure future water flow is allowed. TRC will then remove ice a few inches up from roof deck to avoid any roof damage.

There is extensive management and structure required to organize these efforts as efficiently as possible. TRC has the structure in place to allow you to count on us to be there when you need us.
